Payment Options:

- REGISTER ONLINE via the Civic Rec online portal. Please double check your inscription when submitting the online form at the time of registration.
- CALL the Summit Department of Community Programs at 908-277-2932 to pay with a Visa or Mastercard over the phone and provide inscription with the registrar, which will be confirmed via email.
- VISIT the Community Center at 100 Morris Ave to pay with Cash, Check or Visa/Mastercard and complete this attached form for record of inscription.
- SEND a check to the Summit Community Center, 100 Morris Ave, Summit, NJ (Attn: Mabie Playground) with this form attached.

Choose the size brick(s) you would like to purchase and fill in the spaces exactly as you want the engraving to appear.

- All engraving will be done in upper-case (CAPITAL LETTERS) regardless of how it is printed on this form.
- All engraving will be centered on the brick, you do not need to print it that way.
- Remember to count punctuation marks and spaces between words when you are deciding how much will fit on each line.
